BOTTOM LINE

God wants us to experience life to the full.

SCRIPTURE: John 10:10

I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

IN LARGE GROUP

For many students, the idea of God and church is all about rules and restrictions. It seems to them that God is a cosmic killjoy looking to limit their fun. However, in John 10, Jesus makes a startling statement: "He has come to bring life to his followers." And this is not a ho-hum, dreary, boring life but a vibrant, dynamic, and full life. As we start our journey this weekend, we want students to hear that God has amazing plans for them that don't end with the good news of salvation but continue to unfold and be revealed as they follow Jesus.

DURING SMALL GROUP

Our goal tonight is to break the ice and get conversations rolling. Your win as a small group leader is to get every student to share with the group something new about themselves. Some groups may move beyond that, but be careful. We don't want to hurry past the life-changing truth that no matter where their stories are today, they are God's prized creations. Things will be heavy tomorrow, so let's aim for upbeat conversations tonight.

DISCUSSION GUIDE
