and then one day it did.

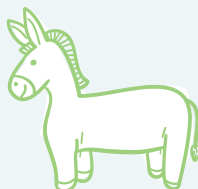
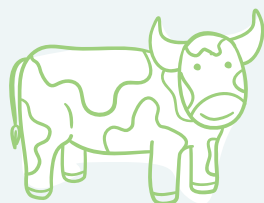
The Christmas Story OF HUMBLE glory

3 *Isaiah 9:6*
"For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."

4 *Isaiah 7:14*
"Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this."

5 *Isaiah 11:1*
"There shall come forth a rod from the stem of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots."

6 *Malachi 3:1*
"I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come," says the Lord Almighty."

7 *Luke 1:26-27*
"Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary."

8 *Luke 1:28-29*
"And having come in, the angel said to her, 'Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!' But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was."

9 *Luke 1:30-31*
"Then the angel said to her, 'Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS.'"

10 *Luke 1:32-33*
"He will be great, and will be called the Son of the High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

11 *Luke 1:35, 37*
"The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called[a] the Son of God."

12 *Luke 1:38*
"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." Then the angel left her.

"and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them."

Luke 2:8-9

"And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. ⁹ An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified."

Luke 2:10-11

"But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. ¹¹ Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord."

Luke 2:12-14

"This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger." ¹³ Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, ¹⁴ "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests."

Luke 2:15

When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

Luke 2:16-17

"So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger. ¹⁷ When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child"

Galatians 4:4-5

"But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship."

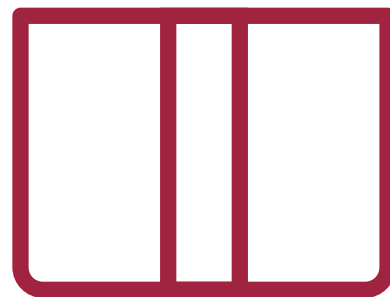

Melting Snowman Cookies!

Prep Time: 20 minutes ❄️ Servings: 24 cookies

You will need:

- ❄️ 24 prepared sugar cookies
- ❄️ 12 large marshmallows; cut in half for the body
- ❄️ 12 mini Reese's peanut butter cups; cut in half for the hat
- ❄️ 12 ounces. White candy melts
- ❄️ 48 miniature chocolate chips for the eyes
- ❄️ 48 pretzel sticks for the arms
- ❄️ 24 orange jimmies or you can use orange gel for the nose
- ❄️ Sparkling sugar or sprinkles; optional

How to Assemble:

1. Prepare your favorite sugar cookie recipe or you can also use store-bought prepared sugar cookies. Have your toppings ready so you can work quickly!
2. In a microwave safe bowl, melt the white candy melts according to the instructions being careful not to overheat the candy.
3. Place half of a large marshmallow on top of the cookie for the snowman's head, leaving some room for the hat. Spoon some melted candy melts onto the marshmallows and cookies, completely covering the marshmallow and spreading towards the cookies' edge.
4. Before the candy starts to harden, press the Reese's peanut butter cup halves to the top of the marshmallows for the hat.
5. Add two mini chocolate chips to form the eyes.
6. Add an orange Jimmie to form the nose.
7. Add two pretzel sticks to for the arms.
8. Sprinkle sparkling sugar on top.
9. Let the cookies sit for at least 20 minutes to harden before serving. Enjoy!

Let's make SNOW!

With these two simple ingredients you can have hours of (slightly messy) sensory fun this winter! This 'faux snow' clumps up like good packing snow to roll up little snowmen, run toy animals or trucks through, or just smash around with your fingers!

What you'll need:

- * 2 ½ C Baking Soda
- * ½ C White Hair Conditioner
- * Plastic Bin
- * Table Covering
- * Glitter (optional)

What to do:

1. Protect your area with an easy to clean up tablecloth or trash bag.
2. Mix conditioner and baking soda in the bin or bowl until a snow-like consistency.
3. Add optional glitter for extra fun!
4. Play!

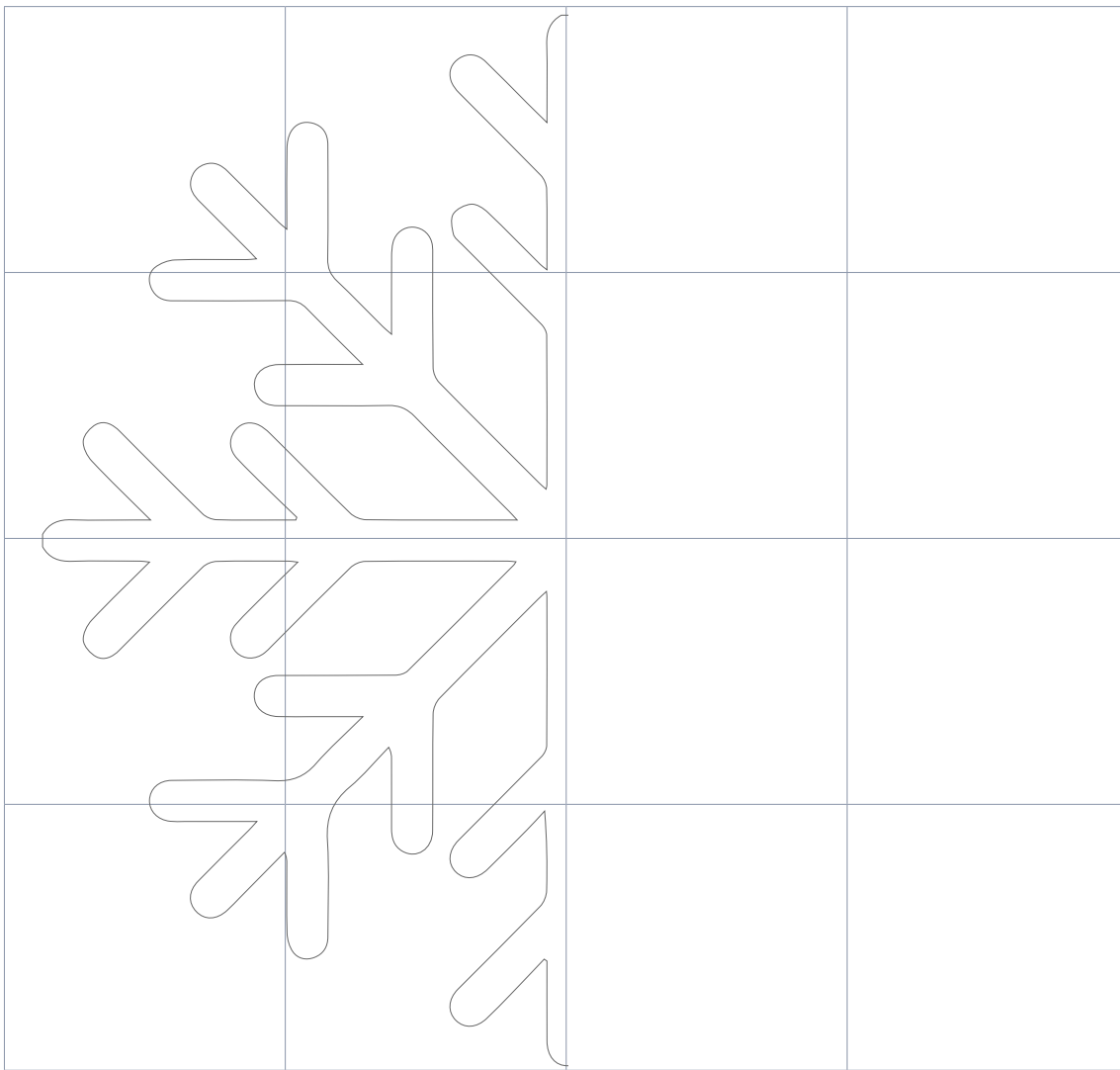
Symmetrical Snowflakes

Snowflakes are symmetrical, meaning each side is shaped the same!

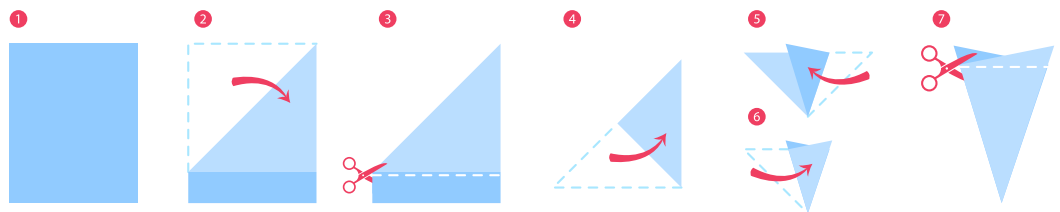


Finish the right side of the snowflake below by carefully observing how the lines appear on the grid on the left.

Stop and think about how big and creative God must be to make SO MANY unique snowflakes every time it snows!



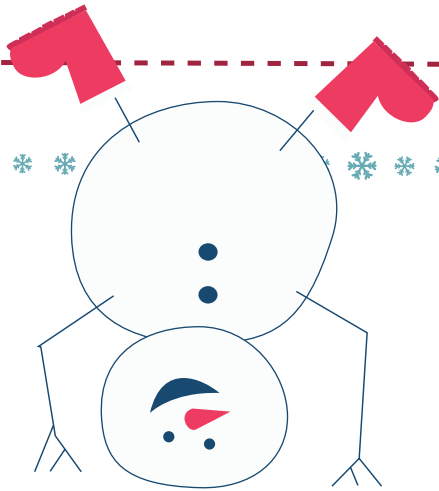

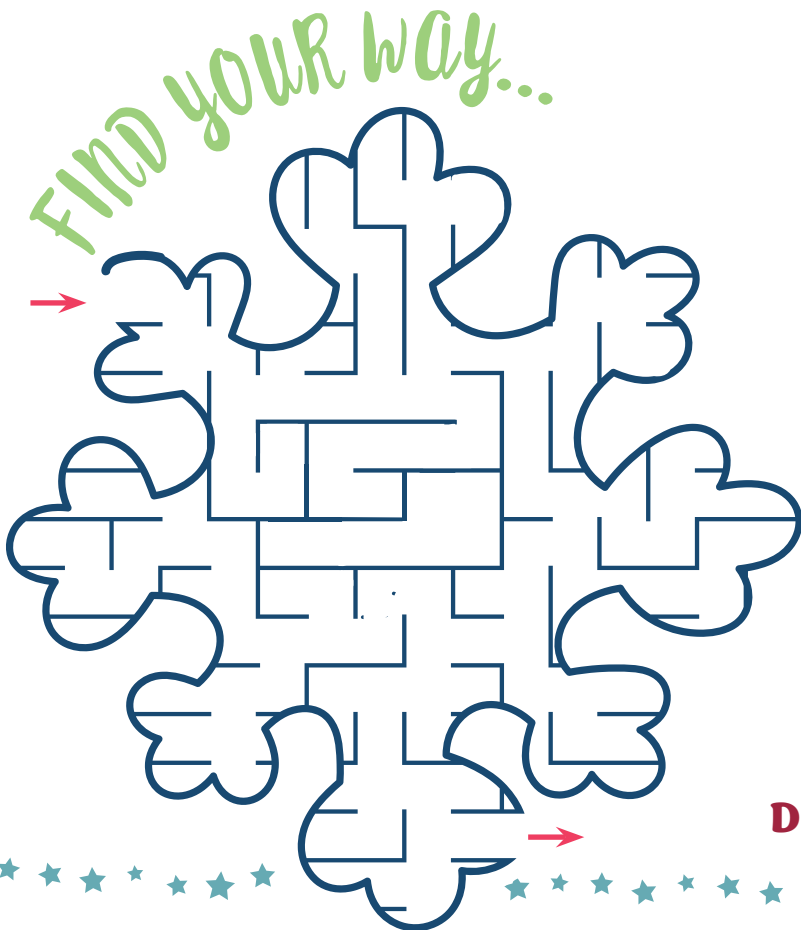

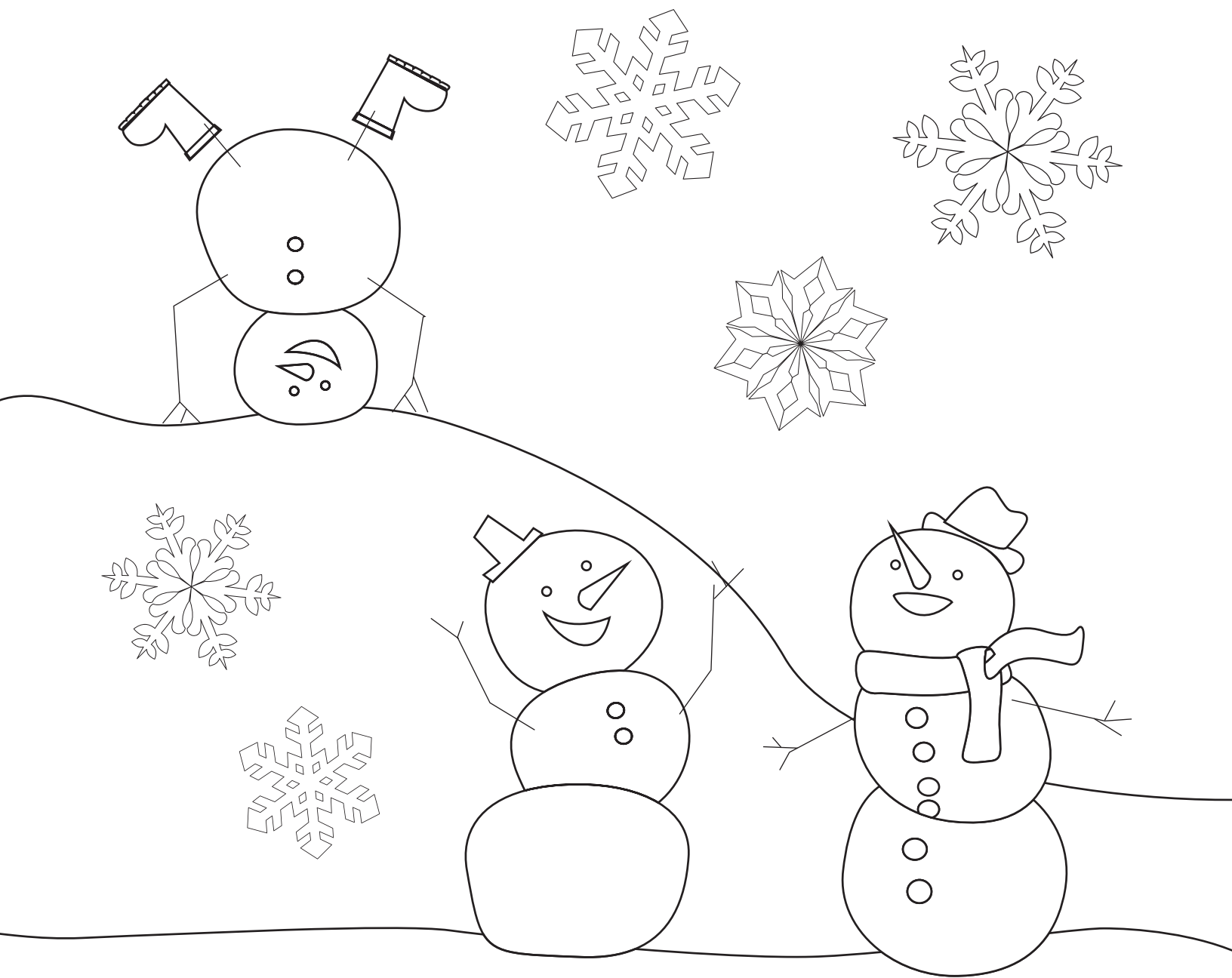
